Where

Arrive at Comerica Park at 8:00 AM!

Olympic Entertainment has generously donated Comerica Park and free parking for HODD 2006. On Woodward Ave. across from the Fox Theater.

From the South – I-75 N. to exit 50 (Grand River Ave.) Stay straight on the I-75 Service drive. Turn right on Woodward. Comerica Park is on the left.

From the West – Take I-94 E. to I-96 E. to I-75 N. to exit 50 (Grand River Ave.). Stay straight on the I-75 service drive. Turn right onto Woodward. Comerica Park is on the left.

From the North – I-75 S., exit on Madison. Stay straight on Madison turn right on to Grand Circus/Witherell St.

From Central Northwestern Detroit – M-10 S. to Grand River exit. Turn left onto Grand River, heading south. Then turn left onto the I-75 service drive, heading east. Stay straight on the service drive. Turn right onto Woodward. Comerica Park is on the left.

From Windsor, Canada/Detroit Tunnel – Turn right on to Jefferson heading East. Get in the far left hand lane and do a loop around so you are headed West on Jefferson. Take Jefferson to Woodward Ave. and turn right, heading North. Comerica Park is about 10 blocks ahead on the right.

What

Join Volunteer Impact as we ‘sweep’ into Detroit for a day of beautification projects. Mark your calendars for May 20 as Hands on Detroit Day continues our 15-year tradition of working together for a day of cleanup and fix-up around Detroit and helping Volunteer Impact at the same time. Our signature annual fundraiser, HODD is important to VI to show our commitment to the City of Detroit and our commitment to the projects that VI has to offer.

The minimum pledge remains only \$25 per person and we will have a family rate for the first time this year, a minimum pledge of \$75 for a family of four, and \$10 for each additional person. Volunteers submitting \$25 or more receive a HODD t-shirt, a light breakfast at kick-off, and snacks.



How

1. Sign Up – To sign up for an event, please call our office, or sign up online by visiting www.volunteerimpact.org and clicking on the “FORMS” tab at the top of the page.

2. Sign the Waiver – The waiver is required for everybody and can be signed at the event or downloaded under RESOURCES. Anyone under 18 must have a waiver signed by a guardian.

3. Pick Your Program – Descriptions for activities at each site are listed on our events calendar. Click on the site for a description of the activities at each site. Volunteer activities include such things as Packaging or Delivering Food, Painting, Housing Rehab and Outdoor Beautification. See the list at left and pick an event where you think you would best like to offer your abilities.

4. Gather Pledges – Print out the attached pledged sheet on Page 2 and start collecting pledges.
