Hands on Detroit Day May 19, 2007

What is it?

Hands on Detroit Day (HODD) is Volunteer Impact's annual fundraiser, bringing hundreds of enthusiastic volunteers together on one day to clean up, fix up, paint, repair, plant, pack and build, helping to create positive changes in the city while collecting pledges to help Volunteer Impact maintain its programming throughout the year.

Corporate teams, church groups, school groups, families and individuals are all encouraged to participate and join in the fun and fellowship by volunteering at HODD on Saturday, May 19 from 8:00 a.m.–1:30 p.m.

Volunteer Impact has been helping improve our Detroit Metropolitan community through hands-on volunteerism since 1990. Volunteer Impact involves over 12,000 individuals in volunteerism and assists over 400 social service agencies throughout the year.

Where Do I Go?

Arrive at 8:00 a.m. at the Campus Martius Park located at Michigan Avenue and Woodward Avenue in front of the Compuware Building. *Campus Martius Park has generously donated the use of the park for the event.*

Parking is available at the Compuware Parking structure corner of Farmer St. and Monroe St.

How Do I Sign Up?

1. **Sign Up** – Fill out the 2007 HODD Registration Form. Everyone is required to sign a Registration Form prior to the event or at the event. Anyone under 18 must have form signed by a guardian.
2. **Cost:** The minimum pledge is \$25 per person and a minimum pledge of \$75 for a family of four, and \$10 for each additional person. Volunteers submitting \$25 or more receive a HODD t-shirt, a continental breakfast at kick-off, and snacks.
3. **Pick Your Program** – Descriptions for activities at each site are listed on our events calendar at www.volunteerimpact.org. Click on the site for a description of the activities at each site. Volunteer activities include such things as Packaging or Delivering Food, Painting, Housing Rehab and Outdoor Beautification.
4. **Gather Pledges** – Use the 2007 HODD Pledge Sheet form and start collecting pledges.
